CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

SPELLING FOCUS

This week, our spelling focus is all about adding the suffix **-ment** to turn verbs into nouns. For example: pay- payment, improve- improvement, develop- development.

ENGLISH TASKS

SPaG

This week, we are looking at the conjunctions 'after', 'before' and 'when.' Today we are looking at the conjunction 'after'. Match the correct parts of the sentences together by including the conjunction 'after'. Please see the video on the Remote Learning page.

MAIN

1. Let's recap on what has happened to Toad? How did he escape? Think about this and/or discuss it with an adult.
2. Read pages 25-27. Think about how Toad might be feeling on page 27. What might he be thinking? What might he be saying?
3. Fill in the think, say and feeling bubbles for Toad. Don't forget to explain how you know. The sheet for this has been assigned to you on SeeSaw. Some of you may want to record yourself pretending to be Toad!

CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

STARTER

We will be using $< > =$ to compare mass. Let's recap what is mass and what $< > =$ mean. Look at the fruit. Can you read the mass of the fruit and complete the sentences.

MAIN TASKS

This week we will be focussing on addition and subtraction. Today we are going to continue to consolidate our understanding of our addition method.

1. What is addition? Let's remind ourselves of how to add without exchanging.
2. Let's look again at addition with exchange. Watch me, then it's your turn.
3. Can you spot the mistake in this calculation? What should the answer be?
4. Let's look at a written calculation. Watch me answer it. The it's your turn.
5. Your tasks have been assigned on SeeSaw.

CHALLENGE

Read the statement below. Decide if it's **Always true**, **sometimes true**, **never true**. Explain why.

When you add two 2 digit numbers together you sometimes get a greater number.

WIDER CURRICULUM TASK- RE/PSHE

RE

This half term, we are looking at the Christian Celebration of Easter. Jesus died on the cross and was then reborn, just like the rebirth of nature as move through the seasons from Autumn to Spring, Spring to Summer etc.

TASK

Think about the four seasons and the 'death' of leaves as Autumn turns to Winter. Spring sees nature's rebirth as flowers bloom and Summer follows. Please illustrate these changes by drawing 4 trees, one tree to represent each season. Don't forget to label which season your tree is representing.

TASK
