CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH



CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS



This week we are really going to nail the written method for division (chunking). Think back to last week and follow the video which has all of the examples you need to get going again. Firstly, though, we are going to revisit those pesky Roman Numerals and Arabic numbers, converting between both examples. Think about the rules to follow and what each of the letters represent before setting your hand to completing the examples set. Continue to watch the video, before completing the division questions on the video. Don't forget to show your working out and include an appropriate fact box.
