

EYFS REMOTE LEARNING PLAN

Tuesday 2nd March – Superworm Day 2

CORE LEARNING TASK

Today, we are going to read the story of Superworm again. Watch the video of Mrs Hanson reading the story and introducing today's learning.

Think about the main characters in the story – Superworm, Wizard Lizard and Crow. Think about how you would describe these characters and the words you would use. Have a go at writing your describing words on the sheets, use your phoneme frame to help you find the sounds to write down.



Now try to create some sentences using your describing words. You could have a go at writing these down or rehearsing them with an adult.



KEY VOCABULARY

Superworm rhyming chant hero villan
character description

MOTOR SKILLS TASK

Curly Caterpillars – today we are going to begin using our special writing paper. Print off a sheet of the paper and then watch the video of Mrs Hanson modelling how to use the lines.

Monster Zig Zags – today we are going to practise different groups of our letters together, by writing words made up of letters from different groups. Have a go at these words –

cup sat dim can got peck rid hob fell

One Arm Robots – today we are going to collect 'worms' using pegs. Make yourself a set of worms, (about 15), using pipe cleaners, hair bobbles or pieces of wool. Spread them out across the table and then using a clothes peg, see how long it takes you to collect up the worms into a jar. Repeat the activity to see if you can be quicker.

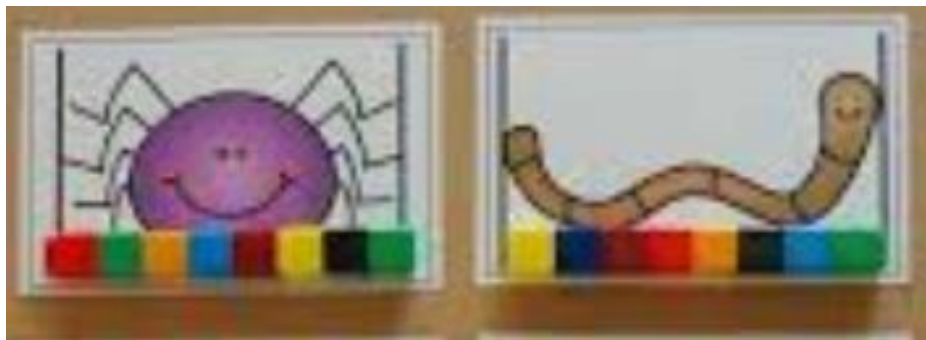
Ladder Letters – today we are going to make different shaped worms, just like Superworm in our story. Think about all the different things Superworm becomes in the story. Use your playdoh (or similar) to create his long thin body, then shape and mould him into lots of different shapes.

MATHEMATICS TASK

Today, we are going to use our Superworms to help us measure. First, watch the video of Miss Brown explaining what to do.

You will need to collect two things that are longer than your Superworm, two things that are shorter and two things that are about the same size.

First, use your cubes to measure the length of your Superworm. Record his length on the measuring sheet. Next, measure the length of each of the other objects using your cubes and record each of their lengths on the measuring sheet. Take a picture of your completed sheet, to put on SeeSaw to show your Key Worker.



PHONICS TASK

BLUES – On **Phonics Play**, play **Buried Treasure**. Select **phase 2** and **/h/**.

YELLOW – on **Phonics Play**, search for **Tricky Word Trucks** and select **phase 2 tricky words**. How quickly can you read each tricky word? Now play '**Buried Treasure**.' Select **revise all phase 2 sounds**.

Practise reading and writing the caption: **a hug and a kiss**

REDS – ask a grown-up to hide the following sounds around your home: **j/v/w/x**. Ask a grown-up to say one of the sounds, can you find it? Repeat with all the sounds.

Practise writing down the words: **box/jam/web/van**

Practise reading and writing the caption: **six jam pots**

PURPLES – Practise writing down the sound you learnt yesterday **/ai/** Today's new sound: **/ee/** On espresso, watch the video on '**Polly's Phonics**' for **/ee/**

Ask a grown-up to draw 6 simple worms (big enough to write a word inside) and write the following words in the middle of a worm:

feet/meet/teeth/sheep Now ask them to hide the worms in your garden. How many words can you find and read?

Now use your phonics and have a go at writing the words down.

GREENS – today we would like you to follow the link and play Phonics Pop <https://www.ictgames.com/phonicsPop/> Choose **/er/ow/** and **/or/**.

Ask a grown-up to draw 6 simple worms (big enough to write a word inside) and write the following words in the middle of a worm:

herd/river/brown/clown/horn/thorn Now ask them to hide the worms in your garden. How many words can you find and read?

Practise reading and writing the sentence: **Miss Brown fell in the river.**
