	Could the 'injury notes' for first aid be emailed to parents instead of using paper?  We discussed how important it was that parents and carers were told straight away about any first aid that had taken place in school and how sometimes adults don't always see emails send straight away. We agreed that paper copies were still relevant. We also discussed how we have reduced our paper use at Sherwood substantially with the use of technology and other effective ways.	
	Can we have more 'environmental lessons' in school.  We explored the curriculum from EYFS to Year 6 and noted that each year group does have an element of environmental study.	
Terra Carta Badge	We explored the challenges set for our Sherwood 'It's Up To Us' badge 2023. SR explained how one of the challenges is being led by the Eco Council. We are to check the use of electricity in classes and give challenge rewards to classes that have turned off their screens/lights when not in the room.  Eco council to take turns visiting classrooms during breaks/dinnertimes to ensure classes are doing this.
