


# <u>CORE TASK 2</u> <u>MATHS</u>

This week, the children have been learning about division.

For homework, please can the children complete the activity in their green homework books. This activity is about solving division questions using the grouping method.

The process involves collecting an equal amount from a group and counting how many groups can be made equally. So, all the groups need to have the same amount in. The amount in each group is the number being divided and the number of groups that can be made is the answer to the division.
