

Suggestion Boxes	 Children brought suggestions from the class suggestion boxes. Recycling day – Year 4 – Children suggested looking at class recycling boxes and bins to see where recycling could be performed where it isn't already. Link this in to a day of making/producing items to be used such as bird feeders, bug hotels, plant pots and growing media, etc. 	MS and council members.

	Class Plant – Year 6 – Suggestion made for every class to have a class plant which the children are responsible for.	MS and JL
	 Make an eco-area on the Junior playground – year 4 – Unsure as to the suggestion of what this child would like. Year 4 representatives to go back and ask for a bit more information. 	MS to discuss with JL. Suggestion for the School council to consider.
	• Greater occurrence of meetings – Year 4 – Suggestion made that we could meet on an even more regular basis to discuss ways of moving forward more regularly.	MS discuss with JL
Climate action plan	Mr Stanton returned to discuss the Schools Climate action planner which would be filled in to produce a School Climate Action Plan. The plan would be shared with the eco council for agreement before being presented, possibly in an assembly, in the New year, for the whole school to follow. This would give us a number of areas to work on to reduce the schools carbon footprint and to help everyone in the school community to understand the issues surrounding the climate crisis and what they can do to act.
