#### CORE LEARNING TASK

First, watch the video of Mrs Hanson on the website.

In the story, One Snowy Night, Percy shares his lunch and then his home with his animal friends. Talk about what it means to share:

- Who do we share our home/toys with?
- Is it easy to share?
- When do you find it hard sharing?
- How do you fell when someone shares with you?
- What would the world be like if nobody wanted to share?

Today's activity involves you getting creative. We are going to make some of Percy's woodland animal friends, so that we can act out the stories we have learnt this week and also create some of our own stories in the park we made for Percy earlier this week.



## MOTOR SKILLS TASK

Today, we are going to practise our writing patterns. In today's video, Jerry showed you the patterns that he had been working on.

Pattern card examples are available on the website, on the EYFS class page – Motor Skills.





#### MATHEMATICS TASK

In maths today we are going to develop our understanding of addition. You will need a dice (or a set of number cards 1-6), 2 small plates, 1 bowl and a set of 12 small objects.

First, roll the dice (or select a card) and count out that many objects onto 1 of the plates, roll again and count out that many objects onto the other plate. Now place the objects from each plate into the bowl. Finally, count out carefully how many objects you have in the bowl. This is your total. Repeat, to calculate different addition questions and answers.
