To put this year's action plan together, I conducted an audit of the competencies of Teaching Staff. Several questions were asked confidentially and fed back to the SLT. These questions had a sliding scale from 1 (Very Good) to 4 (Poor).

From this, it was decided that we would spend some of the Sports Premium on improving staff confidence in teaching Dance and Gymnastics. After looking at the responses, it was decided that this would be for Key Stage 2. I feel the provision for Dance and Gymnastics is very strong in Year 4, so this provision will initially be put into Y3, Y5 and Y6.

As Preston North End's 2018/19 offer has been so positive and productive, we approached them to see if they could continue with the current provision for KS1 and Early Years and add Dance and Gymnastics provision for KS2, which will give those less confident staff a chance to team teach and plan with a qualified and experienced coach.

One staff member suggested a '*Sherwood Dance Festival*' in the Summer Term, where each year group could perform to parents, on the school field. As Dance is one of the main target areas for 2019/20, I feel this is an excellent idea. We will purchase an outdoor PA system so this can be used for practise and performance. It can also be used for school PTA events and Sports Days.
