KEY VOCABULARY

etchings	A print produced by the process of cutting into the surface of a material.
era	A long and distinct period of history.
period	A length or portion of time.
peasant	A poor smallholder or agricultural labourer of low social status.
predator	An animal that naturally preys on others.
prey	An animal that is hunted and killed by another for food.
habitat	The natural home or environment of an animal or plant.
scalene	A triangle with all 3 sides having different lengths.
isosceles	A triangle having two sides of equal length.
