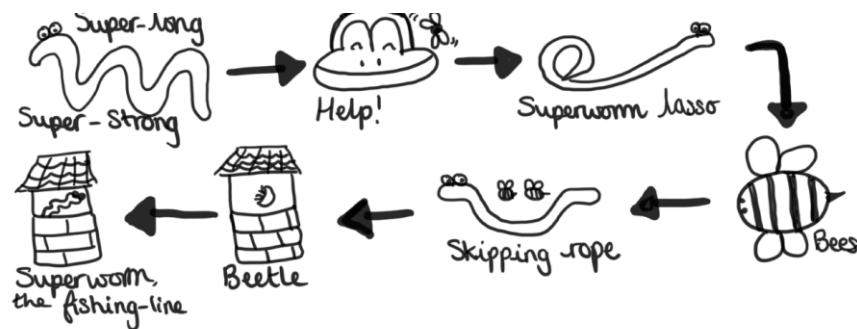
CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

Rosie's Walk

Listen to the story Rosie's Walk read by Mrs Brown. (Available on the EYFS remote learning page)

Draw a story map for the story 'Rosie's Walk'. See below an example from the 'Superworm' story.

Draw a minimum of five pictures using arrows to sequence the story correctly. Use the key vocabulary for Monday's overview for example, 'around the pond' next to the pond drawing. To extend, if appropriate, write a couple of sentences underneath.



CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

Please complete the assigned tasks on Mathletics. Your username and passcode are in the Remote Learning book.

Today we are going to focus on partitioning the number 9 and finding pairs of numbers to make 9

- Collect 9 eggs (you could draw these on paper and cut them out or use balls or stones)
- Draw two circles to represent baskets in your Remote Learning Book or you could draw two circles on the floor outside using chalk
- We are going to look at how many different ways we can make the number 9
- How could you share 9 eggs between the 2 baskets? You could put 2 eggs in one basket and then 7 in the other basket
- Talk about what you have done using a number story. *I have put 2 eggs in this basket. I have put 7 eggs in this basket. All together I have 9 eggs. 2 eggs + 7 eggs = 9 eggs. 2 + 7 = 9*
- To extend your learning write each number sentence in your Remote Learning Book, for example; $2 + 7 = 9$
- See how many different ways you can make the number 9

To extend your learning, see how many different ways you can make any number up to 9! Remember to record the number sentences in your Remote Learning Book.
