CORE LEARNING TASKS FOR ENGLISH

INSTRUCTIONS

Refer back to your plan from yesterday and ask your child to remind themselves about the steps needed to get changed for PE/make a sandwich.

Using the plan as a reference, write set of clear instructions including pictures.

When complete, ask your child to read their instructions, step by step, and do exactly as they say to see if you are successful. (E.g. if they say put the butter on the bread, lift up the whole block of butter and place it on top of the bread – this will clearly show them the importance of writing very clear instructions!) Take photos of this and send to the year 2 email address. Your child should be able to then edit and improve their instructions to make them even better.

When at school, we then ask the children to do an 'independent task' to see if they can apply what they have learnt.

Now see if your child is able to write their own set of instructions using what they have learnt from the modelled write. They should now write a set of instructions for something they know really well and are very interested in.

CORE LEARNING TASKS FOR MATHEMATICS

By the end of Year 2, children are expected to choose and use appropriate standard units to estimate and measure the length and height of objects in any direction- these units are centimetres (cm) and metres (m). Test your child to see if they know how many (cm) make up a (m). Which is the smallest unit? Cm or m? It is important to show the children that when they are measuring an object, they must place their object on the 0 on their measuring tool. Most children start to measure their object from the 1 which inevitably provides them with the wrong measurement. Please ask the children to watch the videos:

Get your child to measure different object around the house using their ruler. Write these in their remote learning books. Try asking your child some questions to apply their knowledge of length. Write these in your remote learning book.
