## Core Learning Tasks for Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2020



### CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

We are so glad that you are all enjoying 'The Scarecrow's Wedding'. Rewatch Mr Wilson reading the story to us all. We would like you today to create your own invitation to the wedding. Be as creative and imaginative as you can.

### PHONICS

We have sent home some phonics guidance booklets to help you to continue to work with your child on their phonics.

#### Teach

Teach spelling the tricky word **when**  
Teach alternative pronunciation of the letter 'i': **find, mind, child, remind**.  
Teach reading of polysyllabic words using alternative pronunciations of 'i' **childish, reminded, grinding, tinopener, mindmap, sticker**.

#### Practise

Ask children to listen to the words, and write them sounding them out carefully::  
**stick, fin, find, fish, child**.

#### Apply

Writing sentences  
He reminded me about the stickers.

Please use this link to Ash's phonics to recap on any of the sounds we have learned previously.

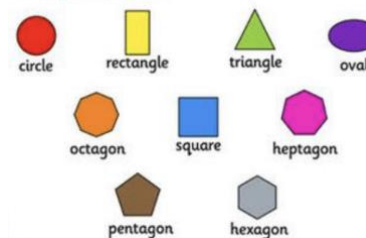
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### CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS
