CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

We hope you have enjoyed reading Wynken, Blynken and Nod. It's good to try reading different things and this is certainly different! Keep reading it!

Today's task is to use your web of words from last week to try and create a **simple, non-rhyming** verse for a poem about sleep.

There are three ways you could do it:

1. Repeat a sentence starting with 'Sleep is...' using the words from your web of words.
2. Write it in the style of a list of words from your web of words by adding extra adjectives and adverbs.
3. Write it simply as a MESOSTIC poem – like an acrostic poem but a little bit different. An example is below – it's a series of short but powerful sentences based on the theme words written down the side. Your theme would be 'SLEEP TIGHT'

At night, the bats flutter around.
Lights go out.
Little is heard.

I don't say a word
Sleeping is easy

Cats chase mice in silence.
Anything that moves, makes no sound.
Let children sleep.
Magic is made.

All this is explained in the poetry tutorial.

Money! Money! Money!



Complete the problem by writing the answers in your remote learning book. Keep it neat. Remember – use a strategy you have been taught in class to solve the problems. Finding change is simple subtraction using the column method! Watch the tutorial again from Week 2.

Try these games afterwards. There are lots of simple ones which build up to harder ones. Check you are always working in the correct currency - £ and p.

g 1 melon and 1 orange	h 100 g of strawberries and 100 g of grapes

Challenge 3 You have £5 (500p). How much change will you get if you buy this fruit?

a 200 g of strawberries	b 1 melon and 1 orange
c 100 g of strawberries and 100 g of plums	d 2 melons
e 1 apple and 100 g of bananas	f 200 g of plums
g 3 apples	h 300 g of grapes
