CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

First, enjoy recalling all about money using Espresso!

We have worked with money this week and remembered to use the skills we know to solve money problems like finding change.

Now solve these mixed money problems. Remember SOME may require addition and SOME may require subtraction. TOP TIP: Change the £ and p to to just pence. There are 100p in every £!

1. One book costs £1.25. How much does 3 cost? CLUE: 125p + 125p + 125p
2. Two apples and an orange cost £4.50. I pay with £5. How much change do I get? CLUE: 500p – 450p
3. I have £3. How much more money do I need to buy all these items. Ball 50p. Sweets 50p. Drinks £2 Books £1
4. Which different coin combinations could I use to buy a £1.27 Easter Egg?
5. Now make up some of your own money problems – it really helps to use some real money.

As a special treat, there is a fun song and dance to sing after your maths...find the video. Wake up and shake up!
