## Practising numbers over 100

1. Play 'Yes or No' - with a partner at home (parents, sister or brother) one of you picks a number between 101-200. That person keeps it in their head. For example 150. The other person asks questions 'Is your number an even number?' You can reply 'yes'. The other person can then ask another question until they guess the number.
2. Add on 20. Pick any number and add on 20. Spot the pattern. Keep adding on 20
3. Start at 190 and add 10. Now repeat but add 11. Repeat but add 12, then 13, 14, 15 etc.
4. Look at the pattern.
