CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

This week, we will be exploring the story of 'Danny, the Champion of the World' by Roald Dahl. We will read sections of the book and then respond to it using a variety of tasks, investigating the characters and how we feel about each of them. 
To begin with, read chapters 1 to 3 of the book and make notes of any vocabulary that you are unfamiliar with. Use wordhippo.com to help and write a definition for those words in your Remote Learning book.

Once you have read and possibly heard the chapters, talk to an adult about what you have found out about Danny. Think about whether he is a rich or poor child, using evidence to back up your opinions. Is he a happy child?

TASK

Based on what you have read, and using words and phrases from the text, can you create character profiles for both Danny and his father? Illustrate them in the style of Quentin Blake if you wish. You could use subheadings such as: appearance, personality, relationships etc.






CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS
