### CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

#### **Can you create a revolting recipe for a potion?**

We think you can – especially if you think about the language Roald Dahl used.

Write it with these titles:

1. PURPOSE: What is the purpose of the potion? What will its special power be?
2. NAME: What will you call it? Give it a revolting name!
3. INGREDIENTS: List all the ingredients - make them rhyming. Here is an example:
  - a. Wiggly, jiggly worms
  - b. Fizzy, whizzy pop juice
4. INSTRUCTIONS: Describe how you will make it. Use describing sentences with alliteration (words that start with the same letter ) and add a splash of repetition for effect. Here is an example:
  - a. Get a grubby goblet and stir, stir and STIR the juice.
  - b. Pick a rusty, rickety saucepan to pour it into.

You might want to add some beautiful illustrations.
