CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

Continuing our theme for this week, we will be exploring and reading the story of 'Danny, the Champion of the World' by Roald Dahl. We will read further chapters of the book and then respond to it using a variety of tasks, investigating one of the themes that we encounter and how we feel about the characters involved.

Further to previous work, begin by reading chapters 4 and 5, if possible aloud to an audience. Don't forget to use a clear voice with appropriate pace and try adding some expression.

Use questioning to understand what you have read,

- What is Danny's dad's secret?
- How do you think Danny feels about his dad's secret?

Once you have read and possibly heard the chapters, explore the website, https://easyscienceforkids.com/all-about-pheasants/ to find out more about this colourful bird.

TASK

Imagine that you have been asked to design a poster to feature in a new hunting magazine. The poster is to advertise the ways in which to poach pheasants. Create a poster which details an explanation of the two methods Danny's dad describes for how to catch a pheasant. Make your poster attractive by including images, an exciting title and words and phrases from the text.

If you are feeling really creative, you could also include an additional method for poaching pheasants which you have invented!
