### CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

On Tuesday, we asked to make changes to the story of 'The Scarecrows Wedding' (they were brilliant!) What we would like you to do is to write your own version of the story. We would like you to really concentrate on using capital letters and full stops. We would like you to use some WOW words and different time conjunctions. We would like you to write this as part of Tuesday's writing task as well. So you have lots of time to write an amazing story!!

### PHONICS

We have sent home some phonics guidance booklets to help you to continue to work with your child on their phonics.

#### Teach

Play Quick copy using words with newly learned graphemes: **child, children, grind, miss, open, doctor.**

#### Practise

Using the words : **open, doctor, not, frost both, cold, go, golden, hottest, focussed.**  
Organise the words into long vowel sounds and short vowel sounds

#### Apply

Writing sentences  
When did the child go to the doctor?
