- Noun phrases/ similes/metaphors
- First person (I)
- Expanded noun phrases, e.g. Mr Wonka turned the key in the small wooden door that lay in front of us.
- How it makes you feel, e.g. I stopped and stared in awe. I couldn't believe my eyes.
