KEY VOCABULARY

Habitat	The natural home or environment of an animal, plant, or other organism
Equator	The imaginary line around the middle of the Earth.
Climate	The weather conditions prevailing in an area in general or over a long period
Ecosystem	A biological community of interacting organisms and their physical environment
Biomes	A large naturally occurring community of flora and fauna occupying a major habitat, e.g. forest or tundra

GEOGRAPHY FOCUS

You have done some wonderful research about The Amazon Rainforest but did you know that every 20 minutes, an area of the Amazon, the size of 20 football pitches, is destroyed? Try and include modal verbs to make your poster more persuasive, and fill it with facts to support your viewpoint.
