Update for Pupils Attending School

As the School Closure continues, please can we ask the following for pupils attending school:

Handwashing

It is vitally important that children wash their hands before leaving home and we will ask the children do this again when they arrive at school. We are washing hands frequently in school. Please continue to reinforce good hygiene practise at home.

Pupil Attendance

Attendance at school is not expected every day by children of key workers. We do request please that children remain at home if you are not required to attend work. School opens at 8am. Pupils must be at School by 9am please so that registers can be returned to the Department for Education.

Bank Holiday Closure

Following consultation with our families, School will be closed on Friday 8th May for the Bank Holiday.

BASE Outdoor Development

The postponed development of our BASE outdoor area commences on Monday 4th May. For this reason, we are moving provision in school to the opposite side of the building.

Drop off and collection w/b 4th May 2020

Please drop off and collect your child from the Y1-2 Entrance (Infant Yard). If you are not familiar with school site, this infant yard can be accessed to the left of the main entrance.

You are welcome to continue using the staff carpark. The gate to the infant yard will be unlocked at 3pm in the afternoon, if you need to collect earlier than this, please ring the doorbell in the Office to get our attention.

School is open until 4.30pm, but there is no set time for collection and varying collection times helps to support social distancing measures. We are unable to allow parents into school and ask that you also do not approach children playing outside.

Breakfast Provision

As we are unable to use BASE for Breakfast facilities, please ensure that your child eats a good breakfast before coming to school. Thank you.

Uniform/Organisation

Pupils need their remote learning books, reading books and a pencil case each day please.

We ask that the children continue to wear their school jumper or cardigan with their own clothes please. For safety reasons, we are continuing to ask children to tie back their hair and not wear earrings please. Mobile phones and camera watches are not allowed in school please.

Safety in the Sun: Please apply sun cream each morning before school. All children require a hat or cap please. If you would like your child to top up their sun cream at midday, please include a non-spray bottle of cream in their bag.

Packed lunches and water bottles are required everyday please. No nut products please.
