Free School Meal Food Vouchers



Information for Parents during School Closure

Miss Barrett is coordinating Free School Meal Food Vouchers each week for children eligible for Free School Meals. A **£15 e-voucher** will be provided each week for **each pupil** during School closure. The vouchers can be spent in several supermarket/food retailers. Parents will receive an e-voucher by email each Monday.

How to register for Free School Meals

Your child may be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Universal Credit with a household income of less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
- Income-Based Jobseekers' Allowance
- Income-Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit, **not** entitled to Working Tax Credit and household income less than £16,190
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Income Support
- Working Tax Credit 'run on' – the payment you receive for a further four weeks after you finish work

Apply by phone

You can 01772 532 109. It must be the person claiming the benefit that rings. You will need to provide your:

- Name
- Date of birth
- National insurance number

They will confirm whether you are entitled over the telephone.
