KEY VOCABULARY

precipitation	rain, snow, sleet, or hail that falls to or condenses on the ground
condensation	water which collects as droplets on a cold surface when humid air is in contact with it
evaporation	the process of turning from liquid into vapour
transpiration	the process of water movement through a plant and its evaporation from aerial parts, such as leaves, stems and flowers
droplets	a very small drop of a liquid
atmosphere	the envelope of gases surrounding the earth or another planet

The water cycle

This week, we would like you to carry out a small investigation and write about what you observe. First, start by watching this clip about the water cycle. Whilst watching the clip note down any key vocabulary.

Then, create your own mini water cycle to observe.

1. Fill a clear plastic cup with 2-3cm of **damp soil**.
2. Cover your plastic cup tightly with one layer of cling film.
3. Watch and record what you see happen over the next couple of days.
