CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

You have **all week** to do this task so **please** don't rush.

Today – plan – just write a few notes and ideas. You know how to do this. Draw some pictures to help too.

You've already written about your potions – so you can return to this and add a lot of that writing into your story.

You will just need to think about the setting, why you want to try your potion on the animal, what will happen to the animal.

Remember – just plan today. You could divide a piece of paper into 6 and draw each part of your story in each part.

CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

Here's something easy to recall in maths. **Coordinates**. It's a great way to remember horizontal and vertical.

Here is a map of a town with symbols. It is divided into squares. Each square has a name which comes from the letter on the **horizontal** line and the number on the **vertical** line. For example, A1. You always put the letter before the number. We call this name of the each square it's **coordinate**.

For example, the **coordinate** of the playground is B2, not 2B.

Can you answer questions 1-7 in your remote learning books.

Now take a look at coordinates on Espresso (Position and Direction Lower). You will find sometimes we write coordinates only using numbers but we still start with the horizontal and then vertical.
