#### CORE LEANING TASK FOR ENGLISH

#### Here's a checklist:

- 4. What happens when you give it to the animal?
- 5. A good ending...

Don't forget – you have already written some great rhymes you can use from previous tasks and you have already written about your great potion – you just need to add that into your story!

Add alliteration, repeating words for effect, rhymes, onomatopoeia (loud words) if you can.
