Events planned are always shared through our School website or paper copies are available to give parents time to prepare. We are always amazed however with the costume ideas that families create without spending a penny.

The majority of our whole school events are often planned or suggested by our pupils through our School Council, Sports Council or by our Reading Champions. We place great importance on our pupils having a voice and we see a greater impact of such initiatives when our pupils are involved in the planning.

Dressing up in character has a positive impact on pupils' empathy, language, vocabulary, inference skills and engagement with reading.
