Throughout school life We've had fantastic support from all the teachers whom have helped our child. we are happy with the help she has been given in the previous years. Thank you.

My child receives all support required from the school, by attending intervention sessions for English and Maths.

My child is happy at school I'm happy with how the staff communicate with me.

I would like more information about how the school works with agencies, such as CAHMS.

School have been proactive when I have shared my concerns, and along with teacher observations and assessment strategies were put into place in year 3 to help my child. My child responded well to some of those. There has always been an open 2 way discussion between us and school as to how they and we can support my child at school and at home. Consistent regular work with pastoral mentor was planned for Year 4 and I am hoping that this will help my child in certain scenarios and build confidence with my child's Writing. Thank you for all your help.

My child has made amazing progress in year 3, I feel she has been supported continuously throughout the pandemic and we have been kept up to date with her academic progress. My child struggles with writing, we encourage her to write in a diary and make shoppings lists for me. My child writes very phonetically and can sometimes get frustrated when she can't hear the sound she's trying to write. We are working on this at home and any updates to her IEP will be followed to support her. Thank you.

I've been very pleased with the support that my child has received and can tell that she has made tangible progress over the last 12 months! So thank you!

I have been really pleased with the extra support my child has been receiving and feel that it has contributed hugely to his continued improvement at school.

I know my son is supported and has an IEP but I don't know exactly what is done for this.

I am quite confident that my child gets all the support she needs at Sherwood.

We know how far our kids are behind and we are doing a lot more at home now.
