CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

Today we would like the children to think about number sequences. A number sequence is a list of numbers that are linked by a rule. If you work out the rule, you can work out the next numbers in the sequence.



The difference between 7 and 11 is 4. So, the rule for this sequence is +4. The numbers next in the sequence are 11+4=15, 15+4=19, 19+4=23.
