WIDER CURRICULUM TASK- ART

For this half term's Art topic, we are going to be looking at Collage. We are going to be focusing on these artists: Henri Matisse, Bridget Reilly and Kurt Schweitzers.

For your tasks today, we would like you to:

- 1. Research the artist *Henri Matisse* and write down 5 facts you have learnt about him.
- 2. Look at a picture of *Henri Matisse's painting: The Snail.* Discuss with an adult what you think about the picture. Discuss how this picture makes you feel? What do you think Henri Matisse has tried to do with the colours?
- 3. Using colouring pencils and paper, colour paper and rip it up into different shapes. Then glue these shapes to an a4 piece of paper or card in the shape of a snail. Miss Rimmer has modelled a video which can be viewed on the website.
