# CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

Today we are learning to recognize and order negative numbers.

Remember that these are called 'negative' numbers and not 'minus' numbers as minus is an operation.

In fact it is 0 minus 4 = -4.

Think about the times you may see negative numbers - floors below ground level in a building or steps into a swimming pool with some steps above and some steps below the surface of the water.

Thermometers are used to show the temperature and at the moment these temperatures will be below zero, especially in the mornings.
