# Spelling Rules for Superlative Adjectives

Rule #	Spelling Rule	Example
1	If the adjective ends in -e, add -st.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>nice → nicest</li><li>safe → safest</li><li>large → largest</li></ul>
2	If the adjective ends in a consonant-vowel-consonant (CVC) pattern, double the final consonant and add -est.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>big → biggest</li><li>wet → wettest</li><li>flat → flattest</li></ul>
3	If the adjective ends with a consonant + -y, change -y to -i and add -est.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>easy → easiest</li><li>funny → funniest</li><li>pretty → prettiest</li></ul>
4	For all other adjectives, add -est.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>tall → tallest</li><li>soft → softest</li><li>loud → loudest</li></ul>

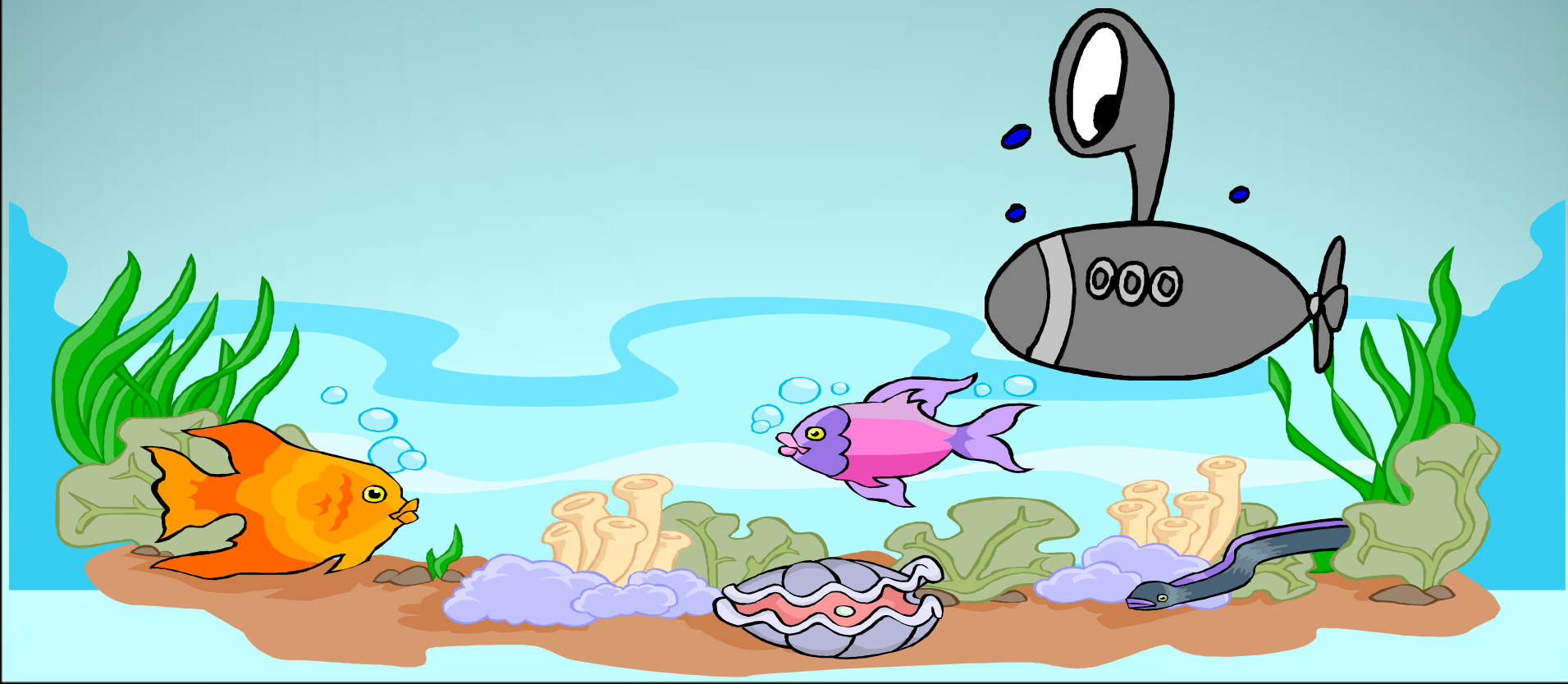
