CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

In English this week we will be continuing to read and respond to Chilly Billy.

TASKS

1. In our Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (SpaG) we will be looking at contracted forms, please watch and sing along to the following video:

2. Today please can you read the text from the remote learning webpage. Miss Rimmer has also recorded a video of herself reading the text for you to listen to.
Make sure you are using your phonics to segment and blend whilst you are reading!
3. After reading, we are going to sequence what Chilly Billy does in a day. You will need to re-read the text and identify the key information. Miss Rimmer has demonstrated how to set out your work on a video for you and modelled using time connectives. Please watch the video and complete the work in your exercise books.

For example:


1. **First, Chilly Billy wake up before anyone else and does his exercises. He jogs, does push ups and swings from bars.**

CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

In Maths this week, we will be continuing to recognise, identify and find different fractions of amounts and shapes. Videos will be uploaded daily to help with this. Today, we are going to be focussing on recognising a third.

Please complete the following tasks:

1. Complete the counting in 2's, 3's, 5's and 10's sheet found on the website.
2. Discuss verbally or write down the following questions:
 - What is a fraction?
 - What does a fraction of an amount or shape need to have?
 - Which fractions did we have a look at last week?
 - What does the word '**numerator**' mean?
 - What does the word '**denominator**' mean?
3. We will be looking at $\frac{1}{3}$ today. Think about how many equal parts there are? How many parts will be chosen?
4. Look at the following image and answer the questions:

 Which shapes represent one third?



Explain why the other circles do not represent one third.

5. Complete the activities assigned to you on SeeSaw.

This week, we will be looking at adding the -est suffix to adjectives. For today's tasks, we would like you to:

1. Recap on the two different ways of adding the suffix -er.
2. Read aloud the following words: **everybody, hold, Mr and poor.**
3. Learn about superlative adjectives from Miss Hough's video.
4. Think of some superlatives to describe the pictures of the landscapes.
5. Write 3 sentences describing the weather today and yesterday.
