We will also be reading more of Macbeth and continuing to use our inference skills to consider and compare character's thoughts, feelings and motives at a point in the story.

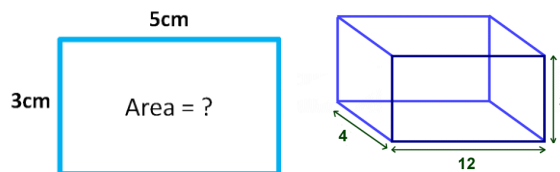
We would also like you to complete a spelling task on spelling **the s sound spelt sc**.
