
What are the rules for making singular nouns into plural nouns?

#### Plurals rule chart

Rules	Singular	Plural
Most nouns just add s.	cat	cats
Many nouns ending with a consonant + y change the y to i and add es.	baby	babies
Nouns ending with a vowel + <b>y</b> just add <b>s</b> .	toy	toys
Nouns ending with ch, sh, ss or x add es.	church	churches
Many nouns ending with for fe change this to a v and add es.	loaf	loaves
Nouns ending with a vowel + <b>o</b> add <b>s</b> .	radio	radios
Nouns ending with a consonant + o add es.	volcano	volcanoes


