CORE LEANING TASK FOR ENGLISH

This week we will be writing our own adventure story for Chilly Billy in Brazil! We will start the week by choosing and planning our story. By Friday we will be editing and improving our work.

<u>SpaG</u>

This week we will recapping using past tense in our writing and identifying past tense verbs. However, today we will be looking at the conjunction 'while' so we can use it within our writing. Please watch the video by Miss Rimmer and have a go at finishing the 'while' sentence. Then, challenge yourself to innovate your own sentence using 'while'.

English

Today we will be planning our story on a story map. We have used these before to plan our story for Cinderboy and Mossop's last chance.

- 1. Choose your favourite Chilly Billy idea from last lesson and tell it an adult, friend, sibling, animal, toy or yourself in the mirror! Say it over and over!
- 2. Use the story map template on the remote learning page or use this template to draw your own. You will need this for the lesson.
- 3. Watch Miss Rimmer's video. Miss Rimmer completes the story map in sections using her own story. Complete your story map at the same time by pausing the video after each part.
- 4. Upload a photo of your completed story map to SeeSaw.

CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

For this week, our theme is going to be all about Division. This links very well to the fraction work we were doing last week. Your tasks are today to:

1. Look at the following sign:



What is the name of the sign? Can you think of any other words which mean the same as this sign?

2. Look at the following calculation:

12 - 2=

How are you going to solve this? Watch the video on the Remote Learning page which shows you how to solve this.

3. Solve the following calculation on your own:

- Tim has 16 bananas. He shares them equally between two boxes. How many bananas are in each box? Represent and solve the problem.
- 4. Please complete the sheets which have been assigned to you on SeeSaw.

<u>PHONICS</u>

The theme for this weeks Phonics is looking at adding the -s and es suffix to nouns to make plurals. For today's tasks, we would like you to:

- 1. Recap what the rules are for adding the suffix -est.
- 2. Read aloud the common exception words for this week.
- 3. Watch the video to understand what a plural is and what happens when we change nouns into the plural form.
- 4. Play the game that has been uploaded online.

5. Write 3 sentences using the plural words from the PowerPoint. Please see the video online to support these tasks.
