

#### P.E.

Thanks for your pictures of you completing the balances and holds from last week. This week we are looking at rolls but we are **not** going to perform a Forward or Backward roll at home – this is too dangerous to do without support.

However, we can do a Sideways Roll and a Rock and Roll into a standing position. Watch the video and see if you can try the moves we looked at last week. Can you video some examples and send it via SeeSaw?
