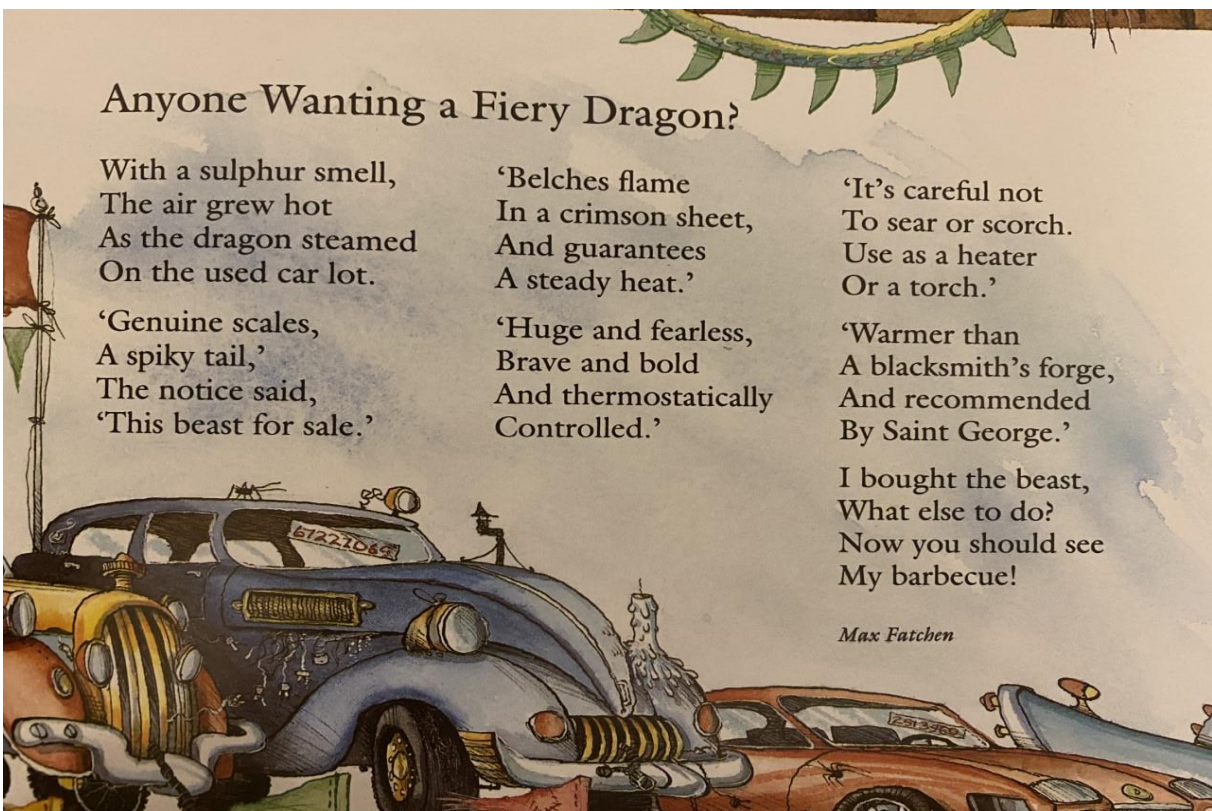
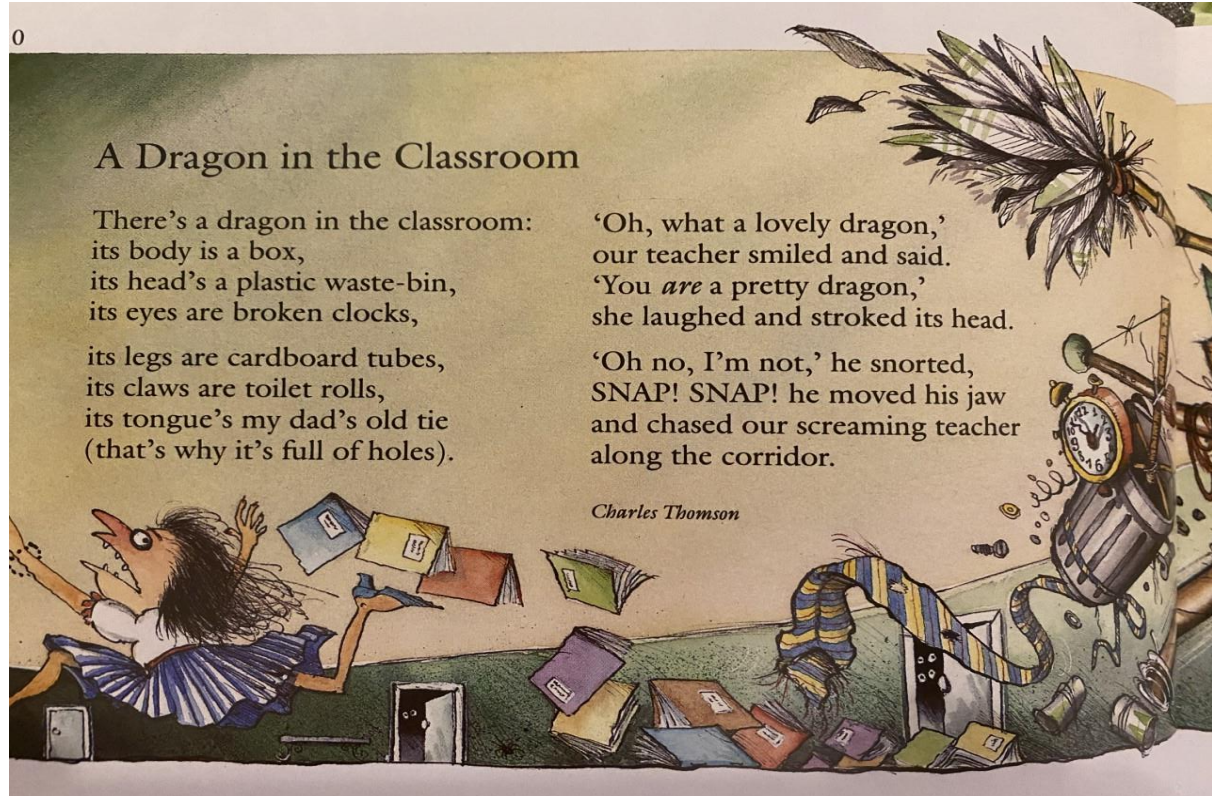

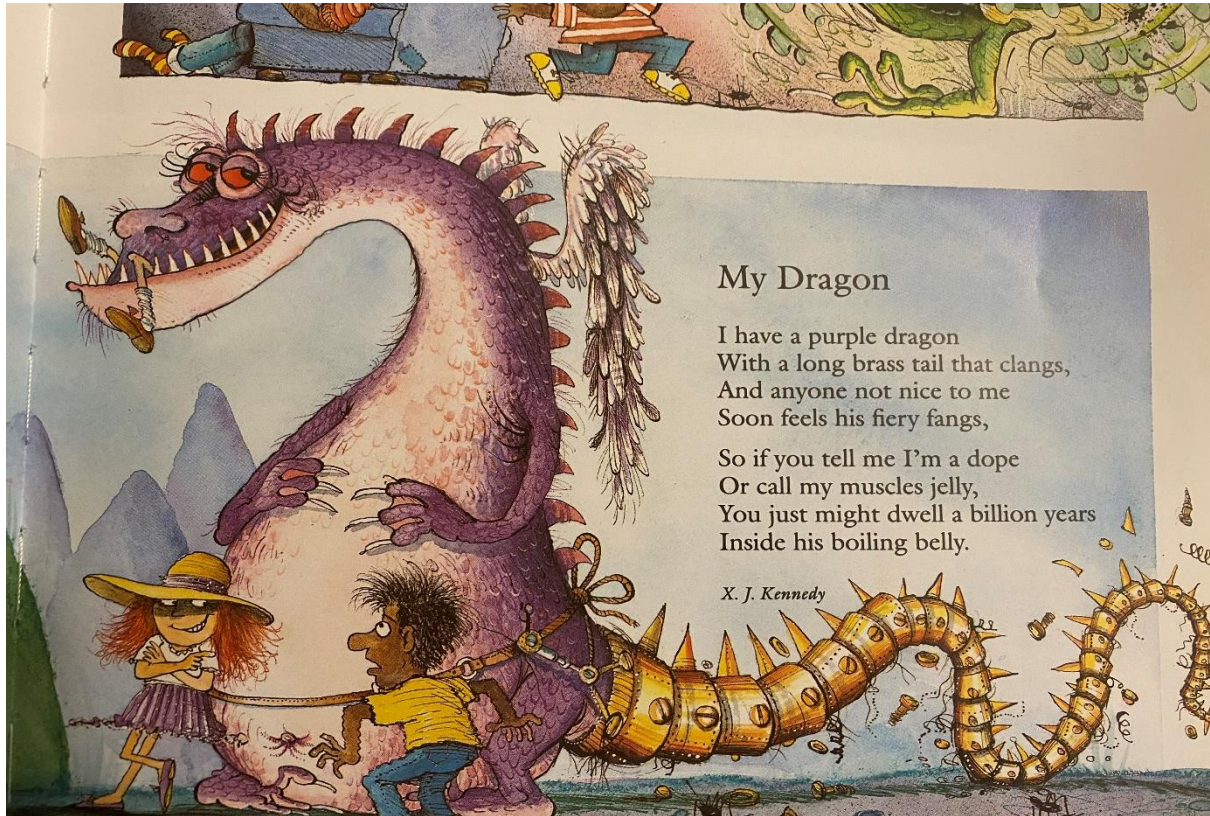
Performance Poetry

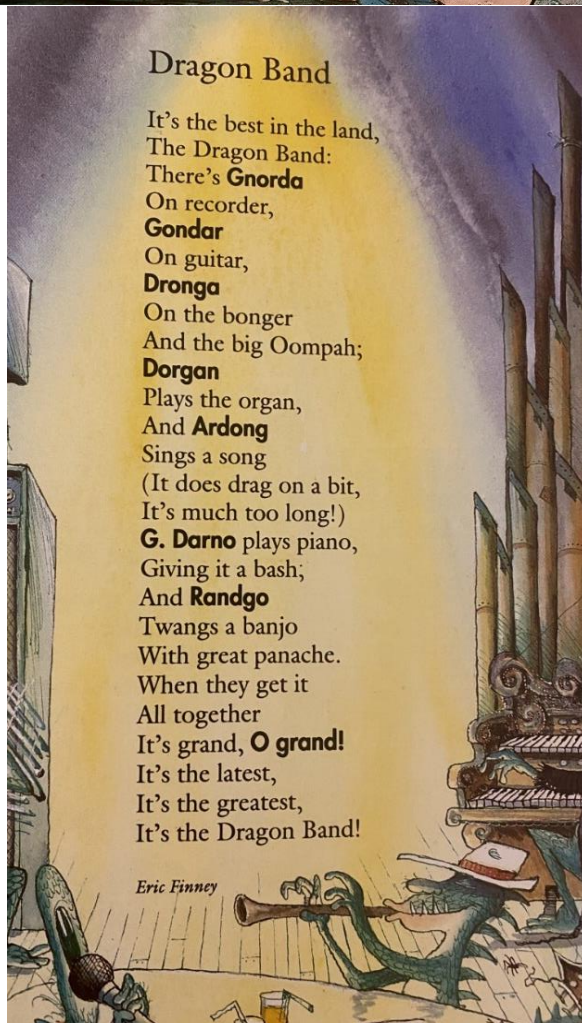

Inside his boiling belly.

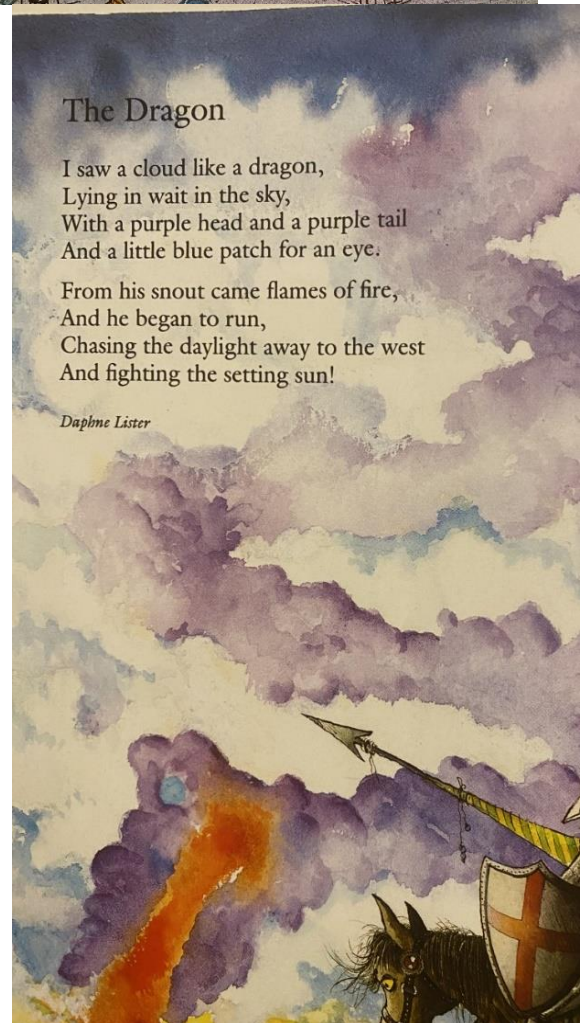
