# EYFS REMOTE LEARNING PLAN

# Tuesday 26th January – Jack and the Beanstalk Day 2



#### **CORE LEARNING TASK**

Today we are going to think more about the story of Jack and the Beanstalk.

Have the children ever been to a market? What was it like? What happens at a market? Explain that some markets sell animals.

Watch the clip of Jack taking his cow to the market.

As the episode plays ask your child to:

- listen and look out for what the market is like
- listen for the sounds that Jack hears

After the episode, talk about these questions:

Why did Jack plead with his Ma?

How much money did Jack's Ma want for Daisy?

What was it like at the market?

What other animals were for sale?

Talk about the animals Jack sees at market and the noises they make. Fold a long strip of paper to make a zigzag book. Label the first page 'When Jack went to market, he saw...' In the subsequent pages, draw a picture of each animal and have a go at writing a label it underneath.

To enhance today's learning, you could have a go at learning this song. Watch the tutorial video.

#### MATHEMATICS TASK

#### Ordering numbers





Today you are going to order numbers.





We would like you to make numbered leaves (Please see below for group information)
Can you remember last Thursday, when





you practised writing your numbers? Make sure those written numbers are facing the correct way.

Using the numbered leaves, we would like you to Blu Tack/stick them to the beanstalk. Place the smallest number at the base of the beanstalk and work your way up the beanstalk, keeping the numbers in the correct order.

Rectangles: Cards 0 – 10 Squares: Cards 0 – 15 Triangles: Cards 0 – 20 Circles: Cards 0 – 30

Remember to take a photograph of your finished work and add it to SeeSaw.

### PHONICS TASK

**BLUES** – please practise all the sounds you have learnt so far in foundation: s/a/t/p/i/n/m/d/g/o/c/k/ Play 'Pairs' using the following words: sat, man, tin, got, kid, cap

Ask a grown-up to write two sets of each word on individual pieces of paper and place them faced down on the table.

How many matching words can you find?

YELLOWS - please practise last week's sounds: h/b/f/ff/l/ll/ss
