STARTER

WIDER CURRICULUM TASK- HISTORY

Task 2

Please can you think about a time where you might have felt an injustice or seen an injustice. How did it make you feel and why?

For example: When Miss Rimmer was growing up, her big brother always took the chocolate out of her advent calendar. It made her feel worthless because she couldn't understand why her brother did it.

Please write this down in your books.

Task 3

Please watch the Rosa Parks video again. This time, please think about how she felt at the different moments and why. Then choose a moment and write a sentence about it.

For example, Rosa Parks must have felt tired of feeling unequal so she refused to stand up because she didn't want any more injustice.
