



CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

Grammar Focus: Watch the tutorial about **prepositions** for position and direction. Practise the **spellings** with the /s/ sound, spelt 'ch.'

Writing Focus: Today, please write out your dragon story neatly, making sure that you edit any spelling mistakes and proof-read your writing to check that narrative and dialogue not mixed up together in the same paragraph.

Watch the tutorial which consolidates how to present our story writing. **Narrative** runs in continuous sentences and the **dialogue** with inverted commas is written on a new line for each new speaker.



CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

This week our focus is mass and capacity.

Today, we would like the children to start with finding the value of each digit in a three-digit number. Select level 3, digit values, up to 999.

Write down your answers and check at the end. See if you can get quicker as you go.
