CORE LEANING TASK FOR ENGLISH

SPELLING FOCUS

This week, our spelling focus is all about adding the suffix **-y** to nouns to make adjectives, for example rain- rainy, wave- wavy.

- Please fill in the chart whereby you have to write the adjective to match the root word and the meaning of the adjective. The template for this is on the Remote Learning page.

<u>ENGLISH</u>

WIDER CURRICULUM TASK- SCIENCE

This week, we are going to be looking at sorting and classifying different seeds.

<u>TASKS</u>

1. Please could you fill out the 'What I have Learned' section on your Plants KWL Grid which you should still have from the first lesson of Science that you completed at home. Tell us all the amazing things you have learnt about Plants.



- 2. In your home, find alferent 3-4 fruits or vegetables which contain seeds (peppers, oranges, tomatoes etc).
- 3. Scoop out these seeds and place them on a flat, neutral surface e.g a white plate, so that you can see the seeds.
- 4. Next, try and sort the seeds into groups. This could be based on the colour of the seed, the size of the seed or the texture of the seed.
- 5. Write down the reasons why you have sorted the seeds into these particular groups. Remember to write in full sentences.
- 6. Send us pictures of your groups of seeds and your writing explaining why you have placed the seeds into the groups.
