CORE LEARNING TASK FOR ENGLISH

SPELLING FOCUS

STARTER

We are looking at fractions of a shape. Please write what fraction of the shape is shaded into your books. The starter video also introduces the main task for today's learning.

MAIN TASKS

WIDER CURRICULUM TASK- SCIENCE

TASKS

This half term, we are going to continue our work on Plants. For your tasks today, we would like you to:

1. Look at the following pictures of 3 plants found in different areas of Earth:



Please write 3 things which are the same and 3 things which are different about these plants.

2. Research some facts about Mars. What is it like on Mars? What are the conditions like there?
3. Answer the following questions and provide reasons why:
 - Do you think a plant would be able to survive in a very cold environment? How do you know?
 - Would a plant be able to survive with much less sunlight?
 - Would a plant be able to survive in a place where the water is all frozen?
4. Now, design a plant that is suited to live on Mars. Based on what you have researched about Mars, think about the characteristics the plant would need to survive and produce seeds on Mars.
