CORE LEANING TASK FOR ENGLISH

What is the title of our story? Who is the author? Is it fiction or non-fiction? Who are the main characters?

If you want to make yourself sound like a character what do you need to do? You need to change your voice! Practise changing your voice to make yourself sound like each of the main characters. Is their voice low or high? Loud or soft? What will they say?

If you want to make yourself move like a character what do you need to do? You need to change your body! Practise standing and moving like each of the main characters. Do they move quickly or slowly? Do they stand tall or bent over? Are their footsteps heavy or light?

Practise acting, moving and speaking as each of the main characters then send videos so we can try to guess who you are being!
