Now watch today's English video and complete the 'Improving Sentences' activity. Remember, you are not changing the core meaning of each sentence, you are just adding detail to make it more effective.

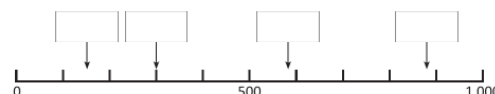
CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS
