CORE LEARNING TASK FOR MATHEMATICS

MENTAL STRATEGIES FOR DIVISION

Today we will be looking at how to break up division calculations so that they can be performed mentally. I will show you a way of making jottings using the part, part, whole model. When you become confident with this strategy it will help you develop a way of picturing how to solve a division problem in your head.

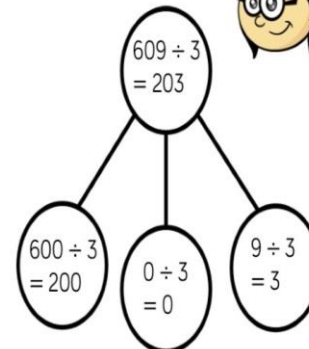
The key, as with many things in maths, is your knowledge of your times tables and your ability to confidently play with numbers to solve a problem.
