
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
Parent/Carer Consultation – Summer Term 2023


Parent/Carer Feedback: EYFS staff are amazing, my daughter adores each and every one of them, they are patient, caring and kind to the children and parents.


School response: Thank you for providing your child with a water bottle each day. We encourage our children to drink at transition points throughout the school day and timetable; end of lessons, breaktimes, PE lessons for example. Our children are encouraged also take their water bottles outside at break and lunchtime.

Thank you for your feedback on keeping active! We are always looking for new ways to keep our children moving! This year we have organised a timetable for the use of our running track at lunchtime. We also encourage parents to walk to school or park further away from the school grounds to benefit from physical activity before the start of the school day. We also promote cycling to school, supervised by a parent as appropriate.


My child does well at this school

Sherwood Primary School makes sure its pupils are well behaved





School response:


Thank you for your feedback, We offer the following reassurance for the academic year ahead:

- When registration opens, parents who book more than one club for their child have places removed and are offered one club only (this is selected randomly by school).
- Spare places are then offered to parents who have expressed interest after registration has closed.
- Each term, attendance is closely monitored. Early registration is offered to children in Spring and Summer Terms who have yet to attend an enrichment club or have expressed an interest.
- In 2022-2023, 80% of children attended at least one before, lunchtime or after school enrichment activity. This was a 13% increase from the previous academic year.
- Activities are carefully planned so that our children can benefit from staff expertise and prepare for sporting fixtures. The number of opportunities available to each year group will therefore vary each term and links closely to the Sporting calendar.
- This year, if registration for a particular activity has closed, please compete our EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FORM for your child. We will contact you if a place becomes available or offer your child an early registration opportunity in the Spring Term. Thank you.


